

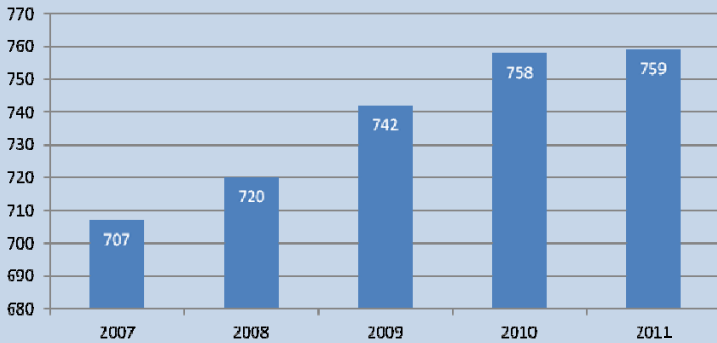


About PUSD
